

CODE OF ETHICS

1. No member shall discriminate against any child on the grounds of religion, ethnicity/tribe, gender and politics.
2. Abusive language and personal attacks should not be tolerated during EC and GA meetings.
3. No member can take any alcoholic beverage before and during both EC and GA meetings.
4. No member can use DCI platform to promote his or her religious belief and political ideology.
5. EC members should not be allowed to take executive positions in any political party to conform to the operations of NGOs as established by laws and conventions.
6. Any member found to have violated the rights of the child on the grounds of the following shall be expelled from the organization and referred to appropriate lawful agency for redress: Rape, Defilement, torture and other child protection issues that have the propensity to impede the proper development of all children.
7. Any member found to have misapplied or misused DCI funds and other logistics should appear a disciplinary committee and appropriate sanctions which include refund, suspension and expulsion and/or police arrest and prosecution, if found guilty.
8. Every member's action and inaction in both private and public life should promote the ideals of the Organization.
